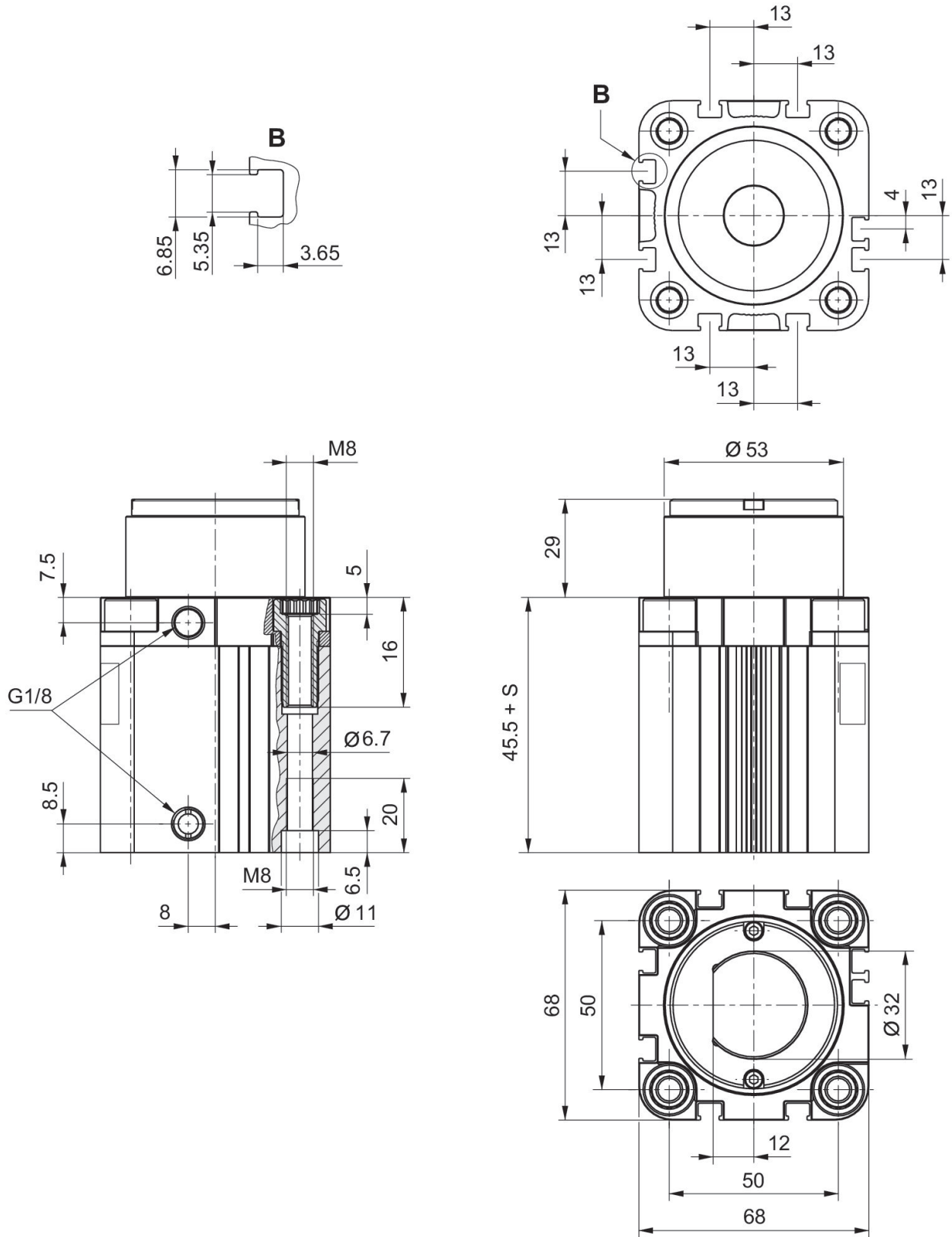
## Technical information

The oil content of compressed air must remain constant during the life cycle.

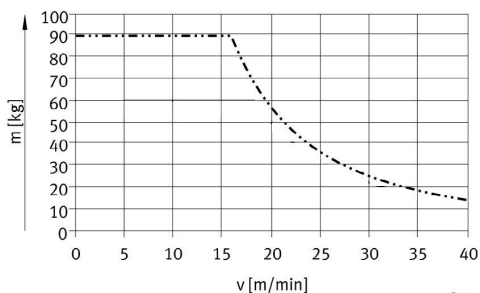

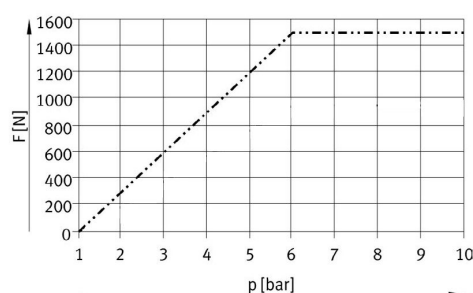


S = stroke
